Better Together #1: We Are Compelled To Love God's Family

Jesus said, A new command I give you: Love one another as I have loved you. Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples (John 13.34-35)

This past Sunday we began "Better Together: 40 Days of Community." Our particular theme was "Compelled to Love God's Family." The life God intends for you and for me is not meant to be lived alone. We need each other in order to flourish and be strengthened by our differences, viewing every person as a highly valued child of God. God has designed life so that we might grow out of our selfishness and learn to place the needs of each other above our own, giving without any guarantee of getting anything back. We do not seek "a spirit of unity" but "unity in the Spirit," placing all of our concentration into opening our hearts to the Spirit and living together in the way of Jesus.

In our devotionals last week, Rick Warren reminded us that we are compelled to love one another as brothers and sisters in God's family because God loves us and commands that we love one another. In fact, loving one another is how we love God. How well we love others reveals how much we love God. Loving one another is a witness to the world that we belong to Christ. Jesus gave the world the right to judge the authenticity of our faith, not by the rules we keep or by how much we say we love Jesus, but by how much we love one another.

There are so many people who will never darken the doors of the church again not because they don't believe in God and not because they don't love Jesus but because of how they were treated in the church or how they saw others treated by the church or how they see people in the church treat each other. They know very well the standard of love taught by Jesus and they see people in the church act so mean and so selfishly, so unlike Jesus that they want nothing to do with the church.

Warren sums up how living a life of love works: God's love for us gives us the *reason* to love others. God's love *in* us gives us the *ability* to love others. God's love *through* us gives us the *way* to love others.

Love is what makes life worth living. Love is what matters most. Are we willing to put aside all other agendas and be known as a church compelled to love one another as brothers and sisters so that Fitzgerald will know that we belong to Christ?






