The Jesus Creed Begins This Sunday

This Sunday, April 7, marks the beginning of a five-week emphasis on The Jesus Creed: Loving God, Loving Neighbor. When Jesus was asked about the greatest commandment he went back to the essential statement of Israelite faith and joined it together with a verse from Leviticus, giving us what writer and professor Scot McKnight calls "The Jesus Creed." The word "creed" comes from the Latin *credo*, which simply means "I believe." When asked what you believe you could do no better than to quote Jesus and say, "I believe that God is one, and God's children are to love God with all that we are and love our neighbor as we love ourselves." In the parable of the Good Samaritan Jesus defines the neighbor as anyone you find in need. This would include, especially our enemies.

Sunday's sermon will introduce The Jesus Creed and the Great Commandment. The remaining four sermons will invite us to see how much God loves us, how we are to love ourselves, what it means to love God, and how our love for others can literally change the world.

We will follow the lectionary readings in worship as they lead us through the First Letter of John and passages from John's Gospel. On Wednesdays at 11:00 and 6:00 we will join together for Bible Study, looking more closely John's First Letter, concluding our study with a look at Second and Third John.

For the season of Easter we will use The Jesus Creed as our Affirmation of Faith. I encourage you to commit the creed to memory and challenge your children to do the same. These words of Jesus are the most important words he ever spoke. They also serve as our guide to a Christian interpretation of Scripture. Make plans to join us!


