The Absolute Wonder of New Life

For the months leading up to the birth of my first grandchild, I was told on numerous occasions: "There's nothing like grandchildren!" Having been a grandparent now for all of 17 days, I've been trying to find the words to express what makes a grandchild so special. There is, of course, the pleasing continuation of the family into another generation. There is the pure delight of seeing, holding, and watching a baby to which one is related - a child that came from your child. There is also the mutual love relationship one anticipates with a grandchild.

I think, however, what makes a grandchild so special is the awareness of mystery that simply cannot be put into words. We have a word for that wordless experience. It's called "wonder." Wonder is what we feel in those encounters too deep for words, moments beyond our comprehension. Who among us, certainly not I, can look into the face a child and not be filled with astonishing wonder! When I held my grandson for the first time in the hospital, when he first looked me in the eyes, and when I just watched him sleep for an hour this past Friday - to describe those sacred moments would be like trying to describe resurrection or a sunrise above the ocean or what it felt like the first time you fell in love.

We are often frustrated or uncomfortable with what we cannot comprehend. Perhaps that's why we often try to explain God in doctrines we can grasp. However, the God of creation can never be fully comprehended. The world God has made is full of wonder. And the love God holds for each of us is beyond words. Jesus could only describe it in stories. God is a shepherd who always searches for lost sheep. God is a woman who will turn the world upside down for a lost coin. God is a father who waits for prodigals to return home, and when they do God runs to meet them.

So don't try to understand or put into words everything you experience. Just open your eyes and let your life be filled with wonder!
