# New Wording for Pastor Search Committee By laws change presented at Conference

At our quarterly church conference on Sunday, February 2<sup>nd</sup> at 1:30pm in the Sanctuary, the church will be asked to approve a ByLaw Change. This change will be in reference to the way First Baptist Church selects the Pastor Search Committee. The change will be:

"The pastor search committee will be composed of nine members, nominated by the deacons, and elected by the church. The committee shall be composed of the Chairman of the Deacons, and eight members at large. The deacons should work hard to nominate a committee that has a "broad and equitable representation," meaning that the committee's makeup should reflect the array of ages, genders, situations in life, areas of expertise and perspective within our congregation. Only one spousal partner or family member should be nominated by the deacons to serve on the committee and no paid employee or immediate family member of a paid employee shall be eligible to serve on the committee. Once the pastor search committee begins the search process, the committee members will not change, even if the leadership from the deacons change. If, for whatever reason, a member becomes unable to continue to serve, the deacons may choose a replacement without the necessity of a church vote."
